The Facts About the Sham Elections of the Mullah Regime

San Francisco, CA – As usual, the mullahs have used fraud to manipulate their sham elections. All of the results that the Islamic republic has announced for the so-called election are fabricated. Even some of the candidates in the rigged elections are protesting against the fraud. All of the regime's previous elections have also included fraud, as different factions of the mullah mafia fight over power and money.

"The mullahs always lie about the results of their elections," said Dr. Assadollah Nasre Esfahani, Chairman of the Iranian Solidarity Congress. "The Islamic republic's interior ministry has no credibility, and the election results that it has announced are fraudulent," he added.

Thousands of Iranians have participated in protests in Iran to object to the massive fraud by the mullahs in the sham elections. As usual, Ali Khamenei has sent his Hezbollah thugs to attack the protesters.

Some in Iran, America and Europe believed Mir Hossein Mousavi's propaganda about "reform." Mousavi has been a member of the mullah mafia for many years, and his claim of being a reformist is completely baseless. Reform is not possible in the framework of the despotic Khomeinist regime, and there are no reformists or moderates in the regime.

Mousavi was the prime minister of the Islamic republic from 1981 to 1989 when the regime tortured and murdered thousands of Iranians. Mousavi was involved in these crimes against the Iranian people.

Those who want to engage the illegitimate mullah regime, and offer a "grand bargain" to Ali Khamenei's terrorist gang, don't know Iran and the mullahs who control the Islamic republic. The grand bargain is a "grand blunder" that will seriously harm Iranians and Americans.

A far better policy is to support the aspirations of the majority of Iranians for freedom, democracy and human rights. In recent years, people in many countries have replaced despotic regimes with democratic governments, and Iranians can replace the brutal mullah regime with a responsible government that does not rig elections and does not kill innocent people.

The mullah regime has never had free and democratic elections. The necessary conditions for democratic elections don't exist within the framework of the Islamic republic. The theocratic regime has banned all pro-democracy parties, imprisoned and tortured thousands of pro-democracy activists, and censors publications and the internet. Furthermore, the jihadist mullahs control all radio and television programs. The regime allows only its supporters to be candidates in elections, and rejects all others. The same gang of terrorists has controlled the leadership positions of the Islamic republic for since 1979 (Khamenei, Rafsanjani, Jannati, Khatami, Ahmadinejad, Mesbah Yazdi, ...). Therefore, the leaders of the regime are not the representatives of the Iranian people.

The Iranian people want freedom, democracy and human rights, and they realize that they cannot be free as long as the Islamic republic exists.

The Islamic republic is a menace to Iranians and the world. The members of the Iranian Solidarity Congress condemn the violations of the human rights of Iranians by the Islamic republic, and we respectfully urge all enlightened individuals and democratic governments to support the Iranian pro-democracy movement.
